Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools in the country, however, the
Board is pursuing to provide extension of affiliation so as to avoid any difficulty for the purpose of admission /registration/ obtaining
renewal of various safety certificates from appropriate state authorities.

Therefore, the competent authority of the Board after due consideration has accorded approval for extension of Affiliation based on
data submitted by school in online application for a further period of 5 years subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

The school will follow the **RTE Act, 2009** and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
The School is required to apply online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per
Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.

The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per
appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer

The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning
in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.

The school should go through the provision of **Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy thereof** for reference
purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates. The School is
expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.

The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school
will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and
girls separately in proportion to the number of students. The school will ensure that Fire, Building, health and sanitation and safe
drinking water certificates are renewed from time to time, as per norms.

Admission to the school is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-laws and rule 2.4.5, 2.6.5, 7.1, 7.2, 8.4.2,
8.4.10 & other relevant rules of Affiliation bye laws.

The school is also advised to follow the 2.4.7 and 2.4.8 of Affiliation Bye Laws regarding Books and Quality of Education.

The genuineness of information / documents / data submitted shall be of school and in case, if found otherwise the school shall invite action as per affiliation Bye laws-2018

The school shall be responsible for submission of any pending compliance, reply of show case /legal notice/ complaint and for submission of date/information sought by the Board. The extension of 05 years shall be from the date of cessation of previous validity of extension of affiliation

The school is required to remit pending fee, if any

The extension of affiliation is being granted as one time measure. However, the cases where the Show Cause Notice was communicated or grievance / legal cases are pending against the school, the Board will take appropriate decision in this matter

The school shall renew all mandatory safety certificate i.e Safe Drinking Water & Health and Hygiene certificate, Fire Safety Certificate and Building Safety Certificate from concerned Govt authorities time to time

The school shall also maintain record of certificate, compliances, data and other records/information and shall be fully responsible to produce all such records before Board and appropriate Government Authorities when asked for, failing which necessary action shall be taken as per Affiliation-Bye-Laws of the Board. The school shall also be liable for action by the appropriate Govt., in case of violation / non-compliance of the concerned Govt. norms

The Board reserves the right to conduct inspection of school as per clause 11.2 and 11.4 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
